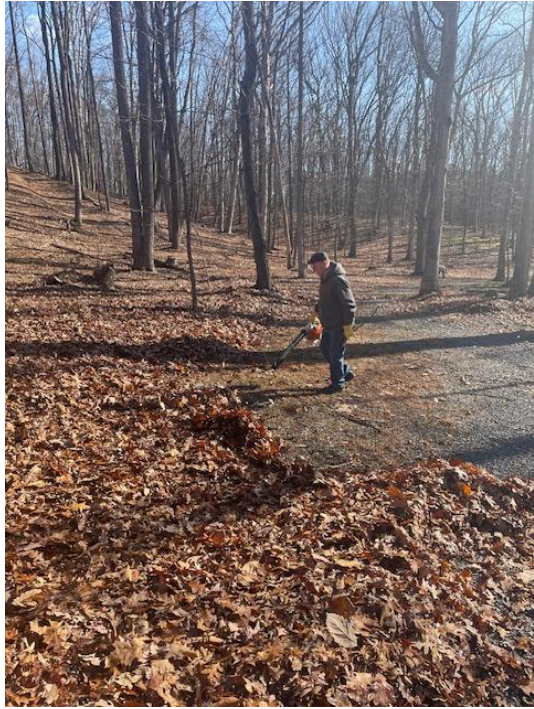
2026 SPRING CLEAN-UP DAY

COMING SOON – MORE PARK IMPROVEMENTS

We are always looking for ways to improve Winter Camp Park's accessibility and enjoyability for all of our Woods' neighbors.

In 2025, we made many improvements to the park, to include pouring concrete floors in the main pavilion, adding a concrete extension to the main pavilion, paving a pathway between the restrooms and main pavilion, adding a paved parking pad adjacent to the main pavilion, and expanding the performance stage.

In 2026, we will continue with these improvements. We will expand the paved pad next to the main pavilion and have it striped for two handicap-accessible parking spaces (intended primarily for pick-up and drop-off; but available for handicapped parking if needed).

We will also pave a pathway connecting the main pavilion to the park's outer loop, making it easier for all visitors to get to and from the pavilion.

Pardon our dust, so-to-speak, when we get these projects underway. Everything we do is with you, our neighbors, in mind.

EASTER EGG HUNT WRAP-UP
