Coronavirus and Park Status

Winter Camp Park is never closed and is opened for folks who want to walk. Please practice "**social distancing**" by keeping at least a safe 6-foot distance between yourself and others, in accord with state and national directives.

The Wednesday Social Hour is on hold until further notice; but if you still want to talk to your friends, there are picnic tables throughout the Park and under the pavilions. Just keep a safe distance. Although we look forward to resuming social activities, there will be no planned events for the summer until the pandemic situation is resolved.

Park Cleanup

Before the coronavirus outbreak, we did have the opportunity to have a spring cleanup, when partners and neighbors got together to blow and rake leaves, pickup branches, chip the branch piles and setup the picnic tables. As the weather improves, we will try to setup the volleyball/badminton net and some horseshoe pits, so that families can have a place to play. You will need to bring your own balls or badminton or horseshoes. Eventually, we will make the Park's equipment available, but not until this pandemic has resolved.

If you need to get out of the house to perform some physical labor, you can stop at the Park. We still need to remove some logs that are located across

the stream and debris in front of the large culverts. Contact us if you want to do this.
