Safety in the Park and May 19 Clean-Up Day

As you visit Winter Camp Park, you will note that it is a “work in progress” and will continue to be so for some time. The walking pathway around the park and the immediate areas around the two pavilions are still undergoing improvements. For those who have lived at The Woods for some time, you will remember that this property was not part of our community and hence not subject to the architectural and aesthetic guidelines of The Woods Homeowners Association or of PVP development. Some areas will be cordoned off with orange hazard tape. Please respect these markers and

recognize that there are still many potential hazards on the site yet to be discovered (buried glass, wires, etc.).

A cleanup day is scheduled for **Saturday, May 19 at 1pm**. Your volunteer help in this endeavor is heartily appreciated. Come with heavy shoes or boots and gloves. Trash bags will be provided.

May 26 - Community Pot Luck Picnic - 5pm!

To kick off the summer picnic season, you are invited to a community-wide picnic on the Saturday of Memorial Day weekend. It is truly “Pot Luck”, so bring a favorite dish to share and your personal beverage of choice. Mark your calendars for a fun event, with an unpredictable menu and spur-of-the-moment activities!

Pavilion and Picnic Tables

There are now two covered areas for family or community gatherings in Winter Camp Park. The second one is nearly complete. Permanent picnic tables have been acquired to “furnish” both pavilions. Electricity is being installed in the first, larger pavilion along with a screen and sound system so we can have “Movie Nights in the Park” soon. As with the rest of Winter Camp Park, the two pavilions are open and free for all Woods residents to use – but donations are warmly appreciated.

To better protect and preserve the picnic tables, there will be a picnic table sanding and staining day sometime after the electric is installed. HISTORY

A group of Woods homeowners purchased 7.73 acres of unrestricted use land, formerly known as the Wills Family Hunting Camp, located across from the Indian Burial Mound on Wintercamp Trail in August 2015. This property was purchased both to protect the land from being used for purposes adverse to our community interests and to provide an area that is topographically well suited to accommodate a park like setting, and even a multipurpose building that could benefit all Woods residents. This is a wonderful opportunity for us to enhance that sense of community that an attractive new area can bring in expanding our quality of Woods life.
