<u>UPDATE ON OUR PLANS</u> — The wetlands survey was done on the property, with areas of concerns marked. This was done after the very heavy rains we had in the Spring. Then a detailed wetlands survey was done to precisely mark the areas of designated areas on the plat. This survey plat has been forwarded to the Environmental Services company who will coordinate with the Army Corps of Engineers to certify the findings. The survey as shown has NO impact on any construction project we have envisioned. We still need to comply but it remains a slight bump in the road.

We continue to receive feedback from homeowners wanting to get more information, volunteer their time and offering monetary support. We already have two homeowners who have committed to funding the construction of two small pavilions of approximately 25 feet by 36 feet in size. We will begin to develop a business plan in a few weeks to better crystalize our plans for the property. We will also be asking for input and feedback from the community.
