Celebrate July 4th Bring your Picnic to Winter Camp Park

Join neighbors and friends at Winter Camp Park on **Saturday, July 4 from noon to 4pm** to celebrate Independence Day and to enjoy the park. While

there won't be a group potluck meal to celebrate this festive summer holiday, the Park is a beautiful place to bring your own picnic. A grill will be available if you care to cook hotdogs, burgers, chicken, etc. Additionally, we will provide paper products and utensils.

We will have games for kids and adults (volleyball, badminton, horseshoes) and whatever else we have available or bring your own.

The open space and Pavilions with separated picnic tables and chairs provide sufficient space and still maintain a safe distance. However, you may want to bring your own chairs; any sharing of food will be your individual choice.

A Porta Potty is now available in the Park.

At this time, we anticipate no dramatic changes in COVID-19 guidelines for gatherings from Berkeley County and WV. Park Cleanup

Prior to the 4th of July event, we are planning a cleanup day on Friday, July 3rd from 9am to noon. This cleanup will be easy. We need to walk certain areas and just pick up branches and stack them in a central location; move around picnic tables and clean them and get games set up for all to enjoy. Just bring your gloves; no cutting grass or trimming, tools, chainsaws, rakes, shovels, etc. at this time!

Walking Paths

With the recent cleanup of the Park, the paths now provide more beautiful vistas of the trees and the stream area. The smaller (red) loop is 1/4 mile while the slightly larger (green) loop is 1/3 mile. For those more adventurous, the Park is an excellent starting point for exploration of trails in Sleepy Creek Wildlife Management Area.
