**UPDATE ON OUR PLANS** - We will be having a wetlands survey done as required by the Army Corps of Engineers, after which we can determine where we place various activities. Because PVP has erected a large pavilion, we will probably not build a similarly sized one. Instead, we may start with multiple small pavilions that can be used by families, and a small rest room. We will further explore this in the next few months, after completion of the wetlands survey. So that we do not interfere with the 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of The Woods celebrations, we are tentatively delaying our "Open House without a House" until Labor Day weekend.
