



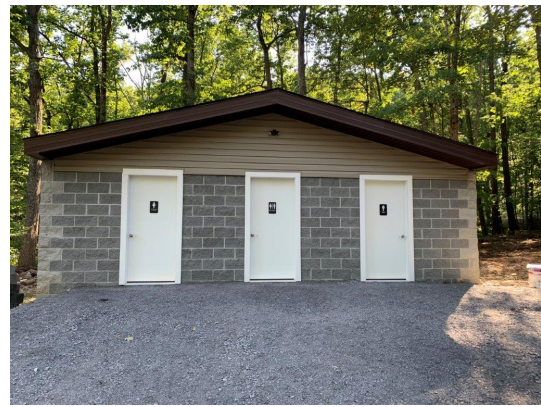

Park Cleanup - Volunteers Needed

Since our January Newsletter, only 4 folks have volunteered! We need more; WAY MORE!!!

Here's what has to be completed:

- **Thursday, March 28 at 9am.**
- Bring your gloves and gas or battery-powered hand-held or backpack

blowers; significant blowing throughout the park!!!

- Bring your chainsaws; 1 tree next to pavilion #2 has fallen and 1 into the creek. And if you have any water/fishing boots, bring them too.
- Cleaning of the restroom inside; we have the supplies.
- Restage all the picnic tables and chairs.
- Setting up the badminton net.
- Adding sails over the event stage; need 6+ foot stepladders.
- We still have firewood for FREE (some already cut); please take it.

If the weather becomes a problem, the cleanup will occur on Friday, March 29 at 9AM.

Opening Date for the Wednesday Social

Wednesday, April 3rd, will be the kick-off for our weekly social when neighbors, friends, and their guests come and meet other Woods neighbors. This is a wonderful way to meet neighbors you might not meet otherwise. This event occurs every Wednesday, rain or shine, under the large pavilion. It starts at 5PM and lasts under 2 hours. Folks normally bring their own drinks and often food to share. You can bring hot (we have electric) or cold appetizers or main dishes, salads, desserts, soups, chili, chips, etc. to share, or just come and socialize. All paper products and utensils are provided.

As a background, this is a **no host** social which was started in 2017 by one of our neighbors. Originally everyone brought appetizers to share, but it has evolved to a true potluck. This was because no one wanted to go home and cook after the social. Now, no one goes home hungry!

Even though this is a very casual event, it does need help to get it set up and cleaned each week. So, we need one or two individuals to organize volunteers for this weekly task. The volunteers only need to arrive a little early, wipe the tables and chairs, and place the paper products on the buffet tables, then put everything away at the end. Setting up takes about 15 minutes and tearing down is quicker, because everyone helps. With 20 to 50 people attending the socials, there are lots willing to take a turn. Neighbors and Friends of Winter Camp Park



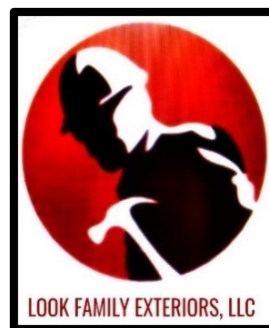
We continue to invite all Woods neighbors to join us as a Friend of Winter Camp Park! With the continued support of our community, we will be able to

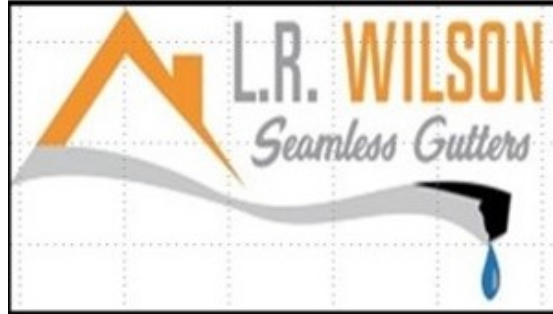
